

## Mendenhall Glacier & Salmon Bake

3 Hours 30 Mins Departing Juneau

Your driver-guide recounts the history of Juneau's gold rush as you depart downtown en route to monumental Mendenhall Glacier. This meandering river of compressed blue ice ranks as the largest glacier accessible by road in southeast Alaska. It runs a half-mile wide, hundreds of feet deep and is fed by the 1,500-square-mile Juneau Icefield. The U.S. Forest Service staff offers a wealth of information on glaciers during your visit and the Mendenhall Glacier Visitor Centre features exhibits, interactive videos and a panoramic view of the glacier.

Then, enjoy an all-you-can-eat upscale, outdoor feast. Savour wild Alaska salmon grilled over an open alder wood flame with a tasty secret sauce, potatoes au gratin, baked beans with reindeer sausage and wild rice pilaf, several salads, cornbread and dessert.
