**Day 1 Arrival Matane Wildlife Reserve** Please make your own way to the entrance to the Matane Wildlife Reserve for check in at the John Visitor Information Centre 3.00pm where the park ranger will direct you to your cabin within the wildlife reserve. Meet up with your guide at the Moose Interpretation Centre late afternoon for your moose observation tour in the mud flats (from viewing platform).

**Day 2 Moose Viewing** Today we would suggest a visit to the Moose Interpretation Centre to gain a better knowledge on this Canadian animal. Please check the schedule for guided interpretation activities. Later this evening (please check departure times at the Interpretation Centre) you will meet with your guide for a 2 -3 hour moose observation.

**Day 3 Departure** Depart at your leisure.
